#### Tips for Applying:

- Be sure to complete all application materials by the above deadlines for email submissions and mail submissions! This includes double-checking with your teacher to make sure he/she has completed your recommendation form.
- Let your personality shine! We are looking for a diverse set of girls and selections will be based on each applicant's interest in science, social and/or financial need, and how participation in this program can benefit her. Girls will be selected to develop a diverse team, reflective of the community.
- Before you begin your application, read over the criteria guide on the next page to help you understand how we will make decisions about GeoGirls selections. When you write your essays, be sure to include information about yourself that lets us know how you fit these criteria.

- The application essays are a chance for us to get to know you: what is your interest in the program and how do you think you can benefit from the program. Before you submit your application, read over your essays and ask yourself:
